On completion of Fita 70 ranking round (approx 1pm) there will be a break whilst archers are seeded for the Olympic Head to Head element. This will be the only planned break during the day. Official practice can be taken during this time.

- 1/32 Elimination: (2 ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes)
- 1/16 Elimination: (2 ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes)
- 1/8 Elimination: (2 ends of 6 arrows in 4 minutes)
- Quarter Finals: (4 ends of 3 arrows, alternating 40 seconds)
- Semi-Finals: (4 ends of 3 arrows, alternating 40 seconds)
- Bronze Finals: (4 ends of 3 arrows, alternating 40 seconds)
- Gold Finals: (4 ends of 3 arrows, alternating 40 seconds)
