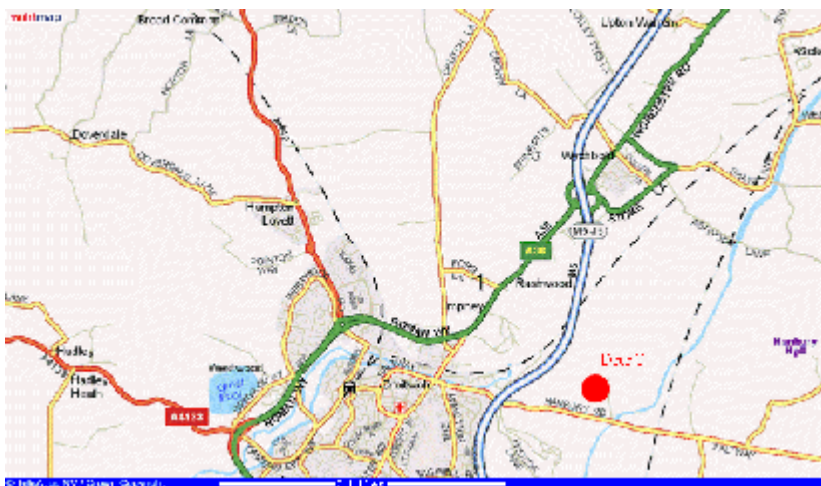


**Droitwich Rugby Football Club

ROUND	Albion / Windsor: 3 dozen at each of the ranges shown below: Seniors: Albion 80/60/50 yds Ladies & Gents U18: Windsor 60/50/40 yds Ladies & Gents U16: Short Windsor 50/40/30 yds Ladies U13 & Gents U 14: Junior Windsor 40/30/20 yds Visually impaired: Burntwood Albion 30/30/30 yds Archers are welcome to shoot <i>any</i> round, but trophies will only be awarded at these distances (or longer). Archers wishing to shoot <i>other</i> than in their allocated round are asked to draw attention to this on their entry form. Juniors wishing to compete for senior trophies must pay the senior fee & state this clearly on the entry form.

Hubert of Liege

(AKA The Apostle of the Ardennes) Born in 656 into the aristocracy, Hubert was passionately devoted to hunting. While hunting a stag on a Good Friday morning, he received a vision of a crucifix between its antlers. A voice warned him, "*Hubert, unless you turn to the Lord, and lead a holy life, you shall quickly go down to hell.*" It was a conversion experience for Hubert, who renounced worldly goods to study under St. Lambert. Eventually he became Bishop of Maastricht and then Bishop of Liege. He died there on 30th May 727, was canonized & interred in the Abbey that now bears his name. His day is 3rd November. St. Hubert is the **Patron Saint of Archery**, Hunting, Huntsmen & trappers – and also the Patron Saint of:

dog bites, dogs, forest workers, furriers, hydrophobia,
Liege, machinists, mad dogs, mathematicians, metal workers, precision instrument makers, rabies & smelters.

Sebastian

Born around 250 A.D. into a wealthy Roman family, Sebastian became an officer in the Roman army, and took part in the Empower Diocletian's persecution of the Christians. However he converted to Christianity whilst visiting them in prison, and in 288 was sentenced to death – by being tied to a tree and shot through with arrows! He somehow survived, only to be beaten to death on the Emperor's orders. His day is 20th January. St. Sebastian is the **Patron Saint of Spain, archers, fletchers, arrowsmiths, armourers** – and also the Patron Saint of:
athletes, bookbinders, diseased cattle, dying people, enemies of religion, gardeners, Huelva, iron mongers, lacemakers, laceworkers, lead workers, masons, plague, police, racquet makers, Rio de Janeiro, soldiers, Spanish police officers, stone masons, stonemasons
